Lilly Scholarship Impacts Recipient and His Family

Dustin Morris's Lilly Scholarship supported him through his four years at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology. But for the Sam and Dee Ann Morris family, the award has meant much, much more.

"This scholarship was a blessing for our whole family," Dee Ann told the Wabash Valley Community Foundation's Program Director Kelli Miller shortly after Dustin's graduation from Rose-Hulman in June.

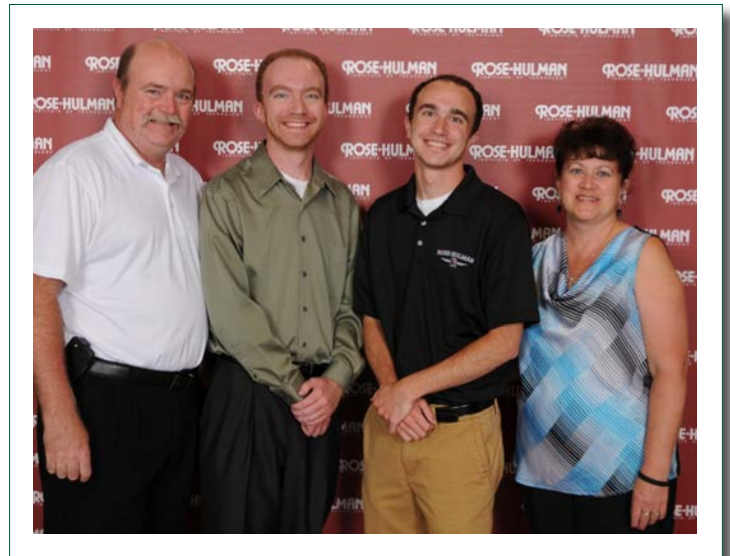
The Morrises have two sons, both graduates of Terre Haute North Vigo High School. Dustin, a 2010 Lilly Scholar, earned his degree in chemical engineering. Austin is currently a Rose-Hulman junior majoring in mechanical engineering.

Sam explained, "We had money set back for both our boys' educations, but even with that there was no way they could both have attended a college the level of Rose-Hulman, so this help from the Foundation and the Lilly Scholarship was a blessing to both of them."

"Not only that," Sam added, "but many parents are forced to delve into their retirement savings to get the kids through college. The Foundation has helped us not have to do that."

Lilly Endowment's Community Scholarship program has made it possible for the Community Foundation to offer the four-year, full-tuition Lilly Scholar awards since 1998. Scholarship committees in Clay, Sullivan and Vigo counties evaluate the applications and make the awards, which to date have gone to 120 graduating seniors.

Dee said Kelli was very helpful in the application process, keeping Dustin on track with all the items he needed to include. Kelli was impressed and gratified when the Morrises paid her a visit at the Foundation office. She said, "The value of the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship is huge for the student recipient, but it

is tremendous for the parents and other children in the family as well. By having one child's tuition and fees fully covered by the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship, the parents are better situated to concentrate their financial resources on the college expenses of the recipient's sibling(s). Five Important Tips for Scholarship Applicants

1. Meet, better yet, BEAT all application deadlines.

The problem with merely “meeting” the deadline means you leave yourself no room to deal with any issues that may arise when you do submit.

2. Read and follow all instructions carefully.

It is always important to follow instructions exactly. In most cases, failure to do so will disqualify your application.

3. Request letters of recommendation early.

Requesting your recommendations should be the very first thing you do, and at least two weeks before the deadline. Be sure to choose people who can speak to your strengths, provide a meaningful recommendation, and to whom you are NOT related.

You should follow up with the recommender at least a week before the deadline to make sure your recommendation will be ready and submitted in advance of the deadline.

4. Your Essay Matters!

Spend some time really thinking about this piece of your application. Scholarship reviewers recognize when you are telling them what you think they want to hear. Therefore, be original, be sincere and above all else, write it yourself. An essay written for you by someone else is typically easily detected, and it will sink your ship!

Last but not least, seek editorial assistance from someone in whom you have confidence in the areas of good grammar and spelling. While the reviewer is seeking to get to know you through the essence of your essay, poor use of grammar, punctuation and/or misspelled words will drastically reduce your chances of getting a scholarship award.

5. Abandon your humility!

Your scholarship application is essentially your sales pitch, so as uncomfortable as it may be, this is one of those times that bragging about yourself isn't merely okay, but encouraged!

Applying for scholarships is a highly competitive process, so emphasize activities that show your talents and passions, especially things that demonstrate your ability to lead, take initiative, persist through adversity, and care for your community.
