Everett and Fern Tucker were born in August 1911 and November 1911, respectively. Everett worked at Hicks Auto Supply for many years before opening his own business – Tuck’s Auto Machine Shop. Fern was a homemaker who had previously worked at Murphy’s Store in downtown Brazil. Before her passing in 2005, Fern established a scholarship fund in her and Everett’s name to benefit Clay County students who plan to pursue a degree in nursing.

Scholarships are a donor’s way of generating legacies by means of creating educational opportunities for generations to come. There are many different reasons why individuals choose to create scholarships. Fern Tucker created a memorial fund in her and Everett’s name to ensure that their dedication to the community would live on. Dr. Crowder’s daughter wished to support students aspiring to be physicians like her father. Jack Lower’s family created a scholarship to carry on his legacy of benefiting students to allow them to reach their goals of higher education and careers.



Dr. James Harvey Crowder, Jr. was born on March 13, 1903 in Sullivan County. He attended Indiana University, the University of Chicago, and Rush Medical College, graduating with honors from both the University of Chicago and Rush Medical College. He had a hand in establishing Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Indiana and Farmers State Bank of Sullivan. The Dr. James Harvey Crowder Scholarship Fund was established by his

daughter, Nancy Crowder Cochran. She created this fund to provide annual scholarships for the benefit of one or more graduates of Sullivan High School desiring to enter the field of medicine, in hopes that they will return to serve the people of Sullivan County.

Regardless of the reason, these community-minded individuals and their families have committed to serving Wabash Valley students **For good. For ever.** Their decision to create endowed scholarship funds to assist students in pursuit of a post-secondary education undoubtedly creates a better future for the Wabash Valley.

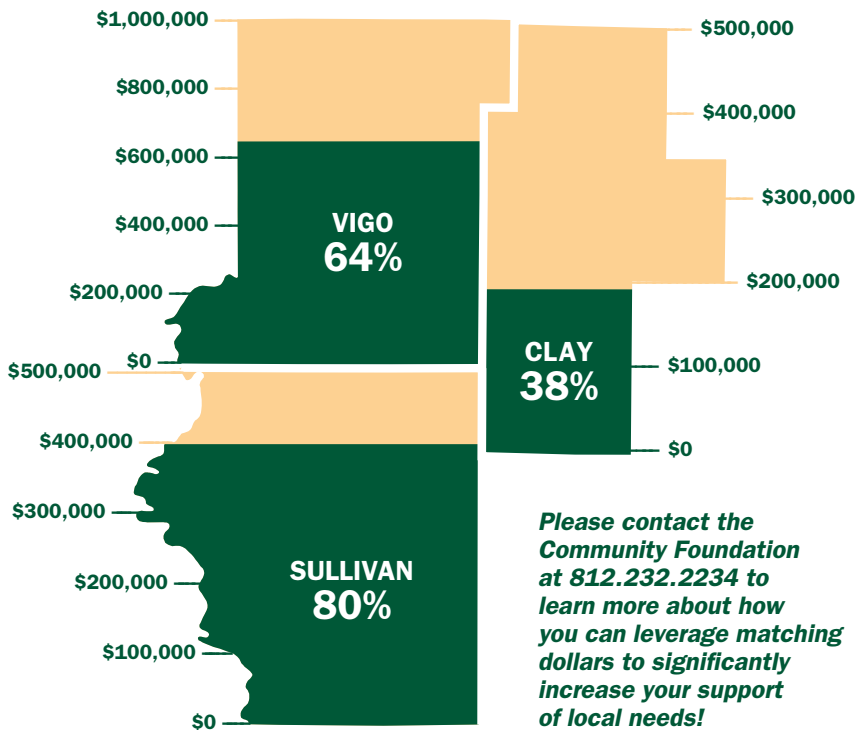

Are you considering applying for a scholarship within the Wabash Valley Community Foundation, but aren't sure where to begin? We suggest you spend some time thinking about the essay portion of your application. Be original, be sincere and write it yourself! To help get you started, below are the top three items to list in your scholarship essay.

1. Career Aspirations

- How did you arrive at your decision? Tell a story to help the reader learn more about you.
- How do your plans relate to your educational and career objectives?
- How do you plan to use your career to contribute to the community? Tell the reader why you deserve this scholarship.

2. Activities Outside of the Classroom

- You have listed your extracurricular and community activities in your application, now elaborate in your essay. Did you hold a part-time job while attending school, or volunteer at an organization?
- Why did you choose these activities? Did these activities enrich your academic, social or personal life?
- How did these activities prepare you for your academic career and beyond?

3. Distinguish Yourself from other Applicants

- Did you receive a prestigious award while in school? Write about it! Your scholarship application and accompanying essay is essentially your sales pitch. If you don't write about it, the reader won't have a chance to be impressed. This is one of those times where bragging about yourself is encouraged!
- Do you have any skills, talents or passions? Applying for scholarships is a highly competitive process, so emphasize things that demonstrate your ability to lead, take initiative, persist and care for your community!

Remember, generous people have generated scholarships for students such as yourself. Higher education costs are on the rise, but scholarships can make it easier and more affordable to attend college. **The application is available as of October 1, 2015 at wvcf.com/scholar_apply.html and the application deadline is 2:00 P.M.
