# CARES ACT INCLUDES YEAR-END GIVING INCENTIVES

Thanks to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act of 2020, individuals may receive greater tax benefit for charitable gifts made before December 31, 2020. The CARES Act makes it attractive for community-minded individuals to help nonprofit organizations with critical needs in 2020.

If you itemize on your 2020 income tax return, you can deduct up to 100% of your adjusted gross income for cash gifts to qualified charitable organizations like the Community Foundation. This is an increase from the 2019 limitation for charitable deductions of up to 60% of the adjusted gross income. If you do not itemize on your taxes, the CARES Act will benefit you too! Individuals who do not itemize are also able to deduct up to \$300 in charitable giving. This will reduce their 2020 taxable income by the lesser of the amount of the charitable contributions, or \$300.

"This is a wonderful opportunity for individuals. Charitable gifts of cash must be made before year-end to qualify," said Beth Tevlin, Executive Director of the Wabash Valley Community Foundation. "It is especially telling that the CARES Act included these incentives to reinforce the importance of charitable giving during these unprecedented and trying times." Gifts made by cash, check or credit card to community, scholarship, designated or agency endowment funds qualify. Gifts made by real estate, appreciated stock or gifts to Donor Advised funds do not qualify under the CARES Act.
