# MCCULLAUGH LEGACY CONTINUES THROUGH CHARITABLE REMAINDER UNITRUST

The Community Foundation recently received a gift of \$112 000 from the Trustees of the Charles M. McCullaugh Charitable Remainder Unitrust for the establishment of the Charles & Melha McCullaugh Scholarship Fund

A charitable remainder unitrust (also called a CRUT) is an estate planning. tool that provides income to a named beneficiary during the grantor's life and then the remainder of the trust to a charitable cause. As one of the organizations receiving funds from the Unitrust, the Community Foundation will ensure the McCullaugh's philanthropic legacy continues in perpetuity through the established scholarship fund

Charles and Melba McCullaugh were lifelong residents of Sullivan County and were considered to be the County's unofficial historians. As the couple enjoyed learning, meeting with people and sharing their wealth of knowledge regarding the community they so loved. Charles and Melba were who you called to find out information from 5, 10 or even 50 years ago.

The couple believed in the concept of giving back and were extremely active in the many volunteer and leadership roles they had. In addition to working at Avrshire Land Company for 45 years and working her way up to become the highest paid woman in Sullivan County Melba was a member of the Sullivan First Christian Church, American Legion Auxiliary, American Shetland Pony Club and Amax Employees 20-year Club.

Army Veteran, After serving, he worked as an auditor for the State of Indiana, Similar to Melba, he was involved in many organizations such as the Sullivan American Legion Post #139. Sullivan First Christian Church. Sullivan Elks, Sullivan Masonic Lodge Scottish Rite and Zorah Shrine. Together, Charles and Melba enjoyed raising, showing and sharing their beloved Shetland ponies with the community - especially children.

Through all of their activities. Charles and Melha set an example of devotion and dedication to enriching lives in their community. Though they could not afford to attend college due to the Great Depression, the couple believed strongly in the benefits of higher education and hoped, through their charitable remainder unitrust, to have the opportunity to help young people of Sullivan County achieve their educational goals.

# USE YOUR IRA CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION TO CREATE A LASTING LEGACY

The Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) will again need to be completed by year's end if you are 70 1/2 or older. One solution to alleviate the potential tax burden (and help our mission!) is to use your RMD to make a qualified charitable distribution (OCD) to the Community Foundation. These tax-free distributions are a financially advantageous way for individuals 70 1/2 or older to turn their retirement savings into a meaningful gift to their favorite charitable organizations. You may wish to consider using your OCD to create an endowment fund or add it to an existing fund at the Community Foundation

OCDs can be used for many different types of funds at the Community Foundation. A designated fund is a great choice if you prefer to support the same charitable organizations each year. These types of funds streamline the giving process by automatically awarding annual grants

to one or more charitable organizations selected by you, the donor. You simply name your fund, choose the organizations you would like to support and make a tax-free transfer directly from your IRA to the Community Foundation to establish the fund. The Community Foundation then handles all the administration and check writing.

In addition to designated funds, the Community Foundation also offers discretionary, scholarship and fieldof-interest funds, all of which can be created with a OCD from your IRA. Funds can be named in honor of your family or business, or can even be named anonymously if you wish to protect your privacy. Due to legislation, OCDs may not be used to create donor advised funds.

In future years, you can simply direct your annual RMD to your fund. Charitable dollars in the fund are invested and will grow tax-free. increasing your impact on the causes

you care about and ensuring your legacy lives on in perpetuity.
