COMMUNITY FOUNDATION RESPONDS TO TORNADO DISASTER

The evening of Friday, March 31, 2023, changed the lives of hundreds of residents within our service area. That night, an EF-3 tornado carved a path through Sullivan County – killing three and destroying or damaging more than 150 homes.

As the day began to break, Sullivan County and City officials were overwhelmed by the extent of the devastation, yet moved by the outpouring of support in terms of food, water, essentials, volunteer assistance and financial contributions. Harmony Walsh, Engagement Officer for Sullivan County, arrived on site in the early morning hours to relay information to and from the Community Foundation regarding immediate needs.

By 2:00 PM on April 1, the Community Foundation had launched the "Help Sullivan Recover Fund" on its website and had received the first donation on its online giving platform. Donations rapidly poured in from across the state and nation to support those affected by the tornado. As of the date of this publication, the fund has received over 900 contributions from more than 32 states totaling

more than \$950,000. The Help Sullivan Recover Fund will serve to provide the funding for the Sullivan County Long-Term Tornado Recovery Coalition, or LTR Coalition, to respond.

"The Community Foundation has been working closely with Mayor Lamb and other Sullivan City and County officials regarding the Help Sullivan Recover Fund," said Beth Tevlin, President & CEO of the Wabash Valley Community Foundation. "These storms deeply impacted our Sullivan County community, which is why we have waived all administrative and processing fees typically associated with a fund held at the Community Foundation. We can assure donors that 100% of the gifts given to the Help Sullivan Recover Fund will go directly toward the long-term recovery efforts in Sullivan County."

Residents of Sullivan, relying upon guidance from the Indiana Volunteer Organization Active in Disaster ("INVOAD") and direction from the Internal Revenue Service on providing funding to individuals for disaster relief, have volunteered their time to form the LTR Coalition with the Community Foundation serving as the Fiscal Sponsor.

The LTR Coalition will allocate the funds raised in the Help Sullivan Recover Fund for the unmet needs remaining after insurance, FEMA payments, SBA loan proceeds and the engagement of local and national charitable organizations and volunteer groups. Utilizing the information provided by FEMA and conducting its own case management, the LTR Coalition will determine a family's unmet needs related to the disaster for presentation to the Unmet Needs Table, and the possibility for assistance from the fund after exhausting all insurance, federal, state and charitable organization support. The LTR Coalition is developing a priority list for assistance which may include factors such as age, number of individuals within the household, and other assistance received among other factors in evaluating the cases. Based on early estimates, the current balance of the Help Sullivan Recover Fund is less than 25% of what is needed. Because of the limited charitable funding available, it is unlikely that all of the unmet needs will be fully compensated. The Community Foundation also provided additional support in light of the tornado destruction. Harmony Walsh lived through the storm at her parents' home in Sullivan. She noted that, shortly after the tornado, EMAs, the fire department and local volunteers went to every door to check in on residents.

"You could feel the heaviness flow throughout Sullivan," said Walsh. "Daylight revealed the remains of homes and businesses and lives that had changed in a matter of moments. Seeing the devastation in the area took my breath away. However, I was inspired by the unity and support from our fellow Hoosiers. People from all over the county and state rallied together to provide food, shelter and support for those affected. Hundreds of volunteers, a semi-truck

full of water and two locations overflowing with essentials – all assembled just hours after the tornado touched down. It was a sense of hope in a time of hopelessness."

That morning, Harmony reached out to The Salvation Army to see what was needed. Learning that snacks and water were requested for those working the response, the Community Foundation purchased and delivered water, food and snacks.

As an additional response, Ally Orwig, Chair of the Sullivan County Services Committee, joined Walsh and Tevlin as they visited the impacted area to determine the greatest areas of need. Shortly thereafter, the Sullivan residents serving on the Community Foundation's Sullivan County Services Committee met and voted to award a \$10,000 emergency grant to The Salvation Army of Sullivan, IN from its Sullivan County Community Grant Fund– unrelated to the Help Sullivan Recover Fund.

"Once Michele (Smith) of the Salvation Army reached out to us for help, we initiated the process to make an emergency grant in the amount of \$10,000 supporting the recovery efforts made on behalf of The Salvation Army," explained Orwig.

"That's the beauty of the unrestricted endowment fund," added Walsh. "Because the donors didn't limit the use of their gift, it enabled our local volunteers to do what they do best – assess our community's greatest needs in the wake of this disaster and respond accordingly."

MORE THAN \$1 MILLION AVAILABLE IN SCHOLARSHIPS!



Students planning to attend college next year may apply for scholarships ranging from \$100 to full tuition. These scholarship opportunities are administered through the Community Foundation for the benefit of residents in Clay, Sullivan and Vigo counties.

A multitude of scholarships are available for students throughout the Wabash Valley who plan to be enrolled in college in the 2024-2025 academic year. In addition, up to four full-time, four-year scholarships will be awarded to graduates of accredited high schools in Clay, Sullivan and Vigo counties who will enter college for the first time in the fall of 2024.

To determine eligibility, students may review the criteria prior to completing an application via wvcf.org/apply-online. The application is available now and will **close promptly at 2:00 PM on August 30, 2023**. TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

In preparation for completing the application, students are encouraged to be ready with the following:

- 1** Financial information from parents/guardian 2022 tax return.
- 2** Two recommendations. It is recommended that students contact their references as early as possible. This allows references (teachers, coaches, employers, etc.) to be prepared to submit their letters of recommendation on time.
- 3** An essay of 500 words or less. This essay should discuss the student's career aspirations, extracurricular activities and what distinguishes the student from other applicants.
